PROCEDURE 2010-2011

TERMS OF MOBILITY:

Foreign student are asked to prove that they have a minimum level in French language and are asked ideally to provide to the administration a proof of an officially recognised French Language Test.

Foreign students are allowed to apply to study at ESBANM within the framework of the 4 following devices:

1- The entrance exam

a) An individual project

It concerns the foreign students who are not eligible to one of the 6 programmes listed to the next point

The application must be composed of:

1. an enrolment form which is available on our website: http://www.erba-nantes.fr/MOBILITE/en/personnal_work.pdf,
2. a curriculum vitae (in PDF format),
3. a statement about your mobility project – use the layout which suits you best, but try to keep to the following headings: *Project title - Project aim(s) – Intended project content – Stages intended for the project – Intended means of the project and Justification of the choice of the ESBANM, linked to the project* (PDF format),
4. a BLOG address where you present your personal work (texts, photos, videos, etc.).

b) A study period

It concerns the students who want to study at ESBANM within the framework of one of the 6 programmes listed below:

1. SOCRATES/Erasmus,
2. C.R.E.P.U.Q (Quebec Conference of Deans and Principals),
3. D.A.A.D/O.F.A.J,
4. Cooperation agreement with the « Concordia university », MONTREAL (Quebec/Canada),
5. *Exchange agreement with « Florida International University », MIAMI (U.S.A), subject to the signature of the renewal of the agreement by FIU.*
6. *Cooperation agreement with the « TOKYO University of the Arts - Gedai », JAPON, subject to the signature of the agreement by TOKYO.*

The application must be composed of:

1. an enrolment form which is available on our website: <http://www.erba-nantes.fr/MOBILITE/en/inscription.pdf>
2. Study contract (learning agreement for Erasmus students),
3. a curriculum vitae (in PDF format),
4. a statement about your mobility project – use the layout which suits you best, but try to keep to the following headings: *Project title - Project aim(s) – Intended project content – Stages intended for the project – Intended means of the project and Justification of the choice of the ESBANM, linked to the project* (PDF format),
5. a BLOG address where you present your personal work (texts, photos, videos, etc.).

Term dates (dates to be confirmed)

1st semester 2010 - 2011:

For students of L2, L3 and M1

September 27th to January 14th
13 weeks of classes and 1 week of assessment

For students of M2

September to March

2nd semester 2010 – 2011:

For students of L2, L3 and M1

January to May
13 weeks of classes and 1 week of assessment

For students of M2

April to June

Christmas holidays:

18th December 2010 to 3rd January 2011

Winter holidays:

5th to 14th March 2011 (dates have to be confirmed)

Spring holidays:

23rd April to 9th May 2011 (dates have to be confirmed)

Deadline for sending files

1. for students who want to apply for the 1st semester or the whole year:

The three next dates for the meeting of the International committee, which is in charge of the examination of the student's applications, are:

- March 30th (deadline to receive the file: March 23rd)
- May 4th (deadline to receive the file: April 27th)
- June 14th (deadline to receive the file: June 7th)

2. for students who want to apply for the 2nd semester:

The two dates for the meeting of the International committee are:

- October 19th (deadline to receive the file: October 12th)
- November 23rd (deadline to receive the file: November 16th)

The study period can be realized in:

- in L2 (2nd year) during the 1st semester, the second semester or the whole year,
- in L3 (3rd year) during the 1st semester or the whole year (*Foreign students are not allowed to study in our institution only during the second semester of the 3rd year.*)
- in M1 (4th year) during the 1st semester, the second semester or the whole year,
- in M2 (5th year) during the 1st semester or the whole year (*Foreign students are not allowed to study in our institution only during the second semester of the 5th year.*)

Choice of the « situations »

Students who are applying for L2 or L3 must **necessarily** choose one situation among the 4 proposed "Constructing, Image, Stage, Editing", while they are filling in the application form.

Diplomas

If a foreign student who is registered in L3 or M2 for the whole academic year wish to apply for the final diploma (DNAP: National Diploma of Fine Arts in L3) or (DNSEP: National Higher Diploma of Fine Arts Expression), l'ESBANM will take a decision individually, awaiting in the same time the decision which will be taken on that subject by the French Ministry of the Culture.

Other information :

- Foreign students have the same status as ESBANM students,
- Foreign students are enrolled at ESBANM in the same year as they are enrolled in their home institution ,
- Foreign students pay no registration fees,
- All classes are given in French, apart from the English class.
